If yes, there are only four simple  
steps to entering the competition:*

- 1. First, find a traditional vessel near you.**  
Keep your eyes open if you live near the sea and visit [www.nationalhistoricships.org.uk/ships\\_register.php](http://www.nationalhistoricships.org.uk/ships_register.php) for a list of historic vessels in the UK and where you can find them.
- 2. Next, visit the vessel and take a great photograph, either of the whole ship or an interesting part of it.**  
Think about its history and try to reflect this in the picture you take. If you can't find a suitable vessel, why not photograph a local seascape, but make sure the picture tells the story of Britain's maritime history in some way.
- 3. Then upload your images to the competition website.**  
And don't forget to get your parents to sign the consent form available online.
- 4. Finally, cross your fingers and wait to see if you are a winner!**

## Competition Categories & Prizes

### ■ Your local historic vessel or seascape

#### ENTRIES BY PRIMARY SCHOOL CHILDREN ONLY

This category is for photos with a maritime theme which demonstrate interest and understanding of historic vessels in the local area.

**Category Prize:** digital camera equipment for your school, sponsored by Olympus and a class visit to an historic vessel near you.

### ■ Your local historic vessel or seascape

#### ENTRIES BY SECONDARY SCHOOL CHILDREN ONLY

This category is for photos with a maritime theme which demonstrate interest and understanding of historic vessels in the local area.

**Category Prize:** digital camera equipment for your school, sponsored by Olympus and a class visit to an historic vessel near you.

### ■ Historic vessels on the National Register of Historic Vessels (NRHV)

#### ENTRIES BY VESSEL OWNERS OR MEMBERS OF ASSOCIATED ORGANISATIONS ONLY

This category is specifically aimed at owners of vessels on the NRHV and is for photos that feature a registered historic vessel, either on static display or in operational use.

**Category Prize:** an evening on HMS *Warrior* (or similar historic vessel based locally) for four people, awarded by Lucas Fettes & Partners Ltd.

### ■ Traditional Maritime Skills in Action **OPEN TO ALL**

This category is aimed at highlighting the use of traditional maritime skills and techniques in the UK.

**Category Prize:** £250 to be spent on maritime-based training, equipment or educational material, awarded by National Historic Ships.

### ■ Classic Boat Favourite: the maritime enthusiast **OPEN TO ALL**

This is a special category, judged by Classic Boat for the best maritime photograph taken by an enthusiast. **Category Prize:** two-year subscription to Classic Boat magazine, plus your photo will be the CB 'Big Picture' of the month.

### ■ Overall winner: National Historic Ships' Photographer for 2010

One entrant will be chosen as the overall winner out of the above categories and the winning photograph will be featured on the front cover of National Historic Ships' 2010 Annual Report.

**Overall Prize:** a monetary prize of £1,000 to be awarded on a theme or activity involving an historic vessel on the National Register of Historic Vessels.
