What was like to be the cook?



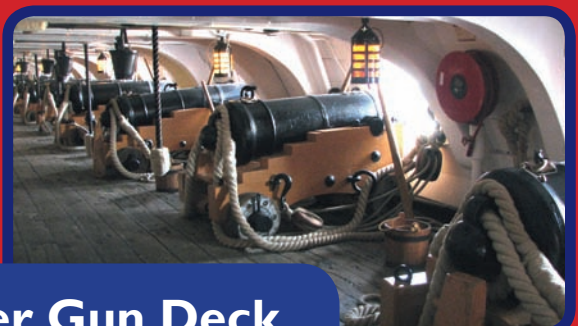
